



COMPLEX DATA VISUALIZATION AND PRESENTATION SKILLS WORKSHOP

This 4 half-day workshop is designed to teach participants how to prepare and convert any complex data into visually attractive presentations. Participants will also learn the essentials of presenting visuals of complex data in an engaging way with digital storytelling.



1st DAY: How To Present Effectively (9am - 1pm)

Participants will attend a theoretical session where they will learn how to present any complex data in a fun, entertaining and engaging way. The real examples and comparative approach to presenting will show participants how to turn the presentations into interesting learning experiences.



2nd Day: Start Preparing Your Data & Slides (9am-1pm)

This session happens behind computers (preferably in the computer lab) where participants are given specific technical tasks, sent to their email address which they will have to read, research, understand and prepare a presentation based on the data given to them. This is entirely hands-on session and participants will work with the facilitator to prepare a presentation. At the end of the workshops participants will leave with the 1st version of their presentation.



3rd Day: What is Digital Storytelling (9am - 1pm)

On the 3rd day, participants will work together with the trainer and learn how to present their findings. In this half theoretical and half practical workshop day, the trainer will teach participants the essentials of digital storytelling.

4th Day: Individual Presentations (9am-1pm)

Participants will deliver their presentations and receive individual feedback. All presentations are recorded for training purposes only and the recordings are passed to the participants.
